Integrated Treasury Management Course with Bourse Game

Setting the Context

Treasury Management Course with Bourse Game is designed to enable the participant to understand the critical treasury management processes in banks and securities markets, such as return on investment, various products and risk-mitigation processes or any entity dealing with large volume of funds. It is expected that Indian banks shall be witness to a large-scale retirement of existing treasury managers, and very few replacements seem to be available.

Objective of the programme

This training program combines robust theoretical foundations with practical applications, enabling treasury officials to not only understand markets, products, and their key features, but also develop the skills needed to assess client needs and offer appropriate solutions.

Pedagogy

This is a fully offline, residential training program held at the NISM Campus in Patalganga. It features case study-based discussions and practical hands-on sessions. The faculties for the session in the programme will be from regulatory bodies such as SEBI, RBI, Banks, NISM, IIBF, and other senior industry experts, all with expertise in their respective fields. Participants will also have access to comprehensive reading materials.

Programme Duration

The training progamme will be conducted over a period of 10 days November 04, 2024 to November 14, 2024. Participants attending training programme on campus will be subject to prevailing guidelines as per NISM Rules and Regulations




