Training Programme on Investigation for SEBI Officers



NISM conducted a Two Day Programme on 'Investigation' for SEBI Officers on September 7 & 8, 2018 at NISM Campus, Patalganga. A total of 59 Officers of the Investigation Department including Officers at the rank of Deputy General Managers attended the programme.

The programme was jointly inaugurated by Dr. M. Thenmozhi, Director, NISM and Mr. V. S. Sundaresan, Chief General Manager & Head of Department -Investigation, SEBI.



The objective of the programme was to apprise the Officers with the nitty-gritty of investigation techniques such as preliminary examination, manual processes, SOP, profile functions, etc., and also imbibe them with the analytical tools such as MS-Excel.

A musical evening was also organized in the evening on September 07, 2018.

First Session



Mr. H R Khan, former Deputy Governor of Reserve Bank of India and the Chairman of the Board of Bandhan Bank Ltd, addressed the students at NISM Campus on September 21, 2018.

Dr. M. Thenmozhi, Director, while welcoming Mr.Khan shared the road map of NISM in the areas of academic research and she also spoke about the various research projects on which NISM is working on at present.

Mr. Khan spoke in details about the issues and challenges of corporate bond markets in India. He also discussed in detail the "7-Is framework for development of corporate bond market in India. These 7Is are Issuer, Investor, Intermediaries, Infrastructure, Incentives, Instruments, and Innovation. It was followed by Q&A session. The students and faculties immensely benefited from his session, which was full of insight and wisdom.

Second Session



In the Second Session held on September 28, 2018, Mr. Saurabh Mukherjea, founder of Marcellus Investment Management and author of the book 'Coffee Can Investing', addressed the students at NISM Campus.

Dr. M. Thenmozhi, Director, while inaugurating the programme, detailed the current academic activities of NISM as wells the road ahead.

Mr. Mukherjea explained in detail about 'Coffee Can Portfolio'. He was of the view that one has to avoid investment in real estate, gold, any other physical asset etc. for wealth creation. Rather, one has to follow the principle of 'coffee can investing' in equity.
