Why this Conference

In May 2018, SEBI had introduced the new governance code for publicly listed companies based on the recommendations of Uday Kotak Committee. It is pertinent to mention that many of the mandatory requirements such as appointment of at-least one independent woman director on the Board, minimum number of directorships in the Board, cap on maximum number of directorships, etc., would be in effect starting April 1, 2019.

The objective of the Conference is to sensitize top level leaders vis-à-vis Chief Executive Officers, Board of Directors and Managing Directors of listed companies about the intent of the amended Regulations, make them aware of the benefits of these changes and also to provide clarity wherever required.

The conference will also serve as a platform for direct dialogue between the Regulator and Top Leadership of listed companies to disseminate the rationale behind the regulations and address bottlenecks, if any, in implementing the new Code.


