

Exam Instructions for NISM Remote proctored examinations (Windows OS + Webcam + Microphone User):

1. NISM Remote proctored examinations are conducted in online mode wherein candidates are monitored virtually in real time by live proctor throughout the examination
2. Kindly ensure that your computer system has a functional webcam and microphone, and that you are seated in a quiet, isolated environment while appearing for the examination.
3. The examination is based on Dual Camera setting wherein the mobile phone should be positioned 1 meter away from the candidate, on either the left or right side.
4. The phone must be set capturing the candidate's side profile, both hands, monitor, and desk.
5. All candidates will receive a separate email from NISM containing the examination invitation, along with the links to **Start Test** and **Check System Compatibility**. If the email is not received, candidates are advised to check their Spam or Junk folder.
6. The **Start Test** button will be active from **15 minutes before** the scheduled examination start time until **15 minutes after** the scheduled start time.

*For example, if your examination is scheduled to begin at **10:00 AM**, the **Start Test** button will be available from **9:45 AM to 10:15 AM**.*

7. To avoid any delays or technical issues on the examination day, candidates are strongly advised to complete the **Sample Test** as soon as they receive the examination invitation email.
8. Ensure to keep the following Photo Identity proofs in original with you for authorization before exam, without which you will not be allowed for the exam.
 - PAN Card
 - UID (Aadhar Card)
 - Driving License
 - Passport

Any of these documents stored in Digi-Locker, provided such document has the candidate's photograph embedded in it.

9.If the live proctor observes any suspicious activity during the examination, they may issue a warning and temporarily pause the examination. The proctor may also request the candidate to provide additional verification, such as displaying a 360-degree view of the examination surroundings or furnishing any other information necessary to ensure the integrity of the examination.

10. Failure to comply with the instructions issued by the live proctor may result in the immediate termination of the examination. Depending on the nature and severity of the violation, the proctor may terminate the examination with or without issuing a prior warning.

Mandatory System Requirements for NISM Remote Proctored Examination

Mandatory Technical Requirements

Candidates must ensure that their system meets the following technical requirements before appearing for the NISM Remote Proctored Examination:

1. **Internet Speed**
 - Minimum Download Speed: **512 kbps**
 - Minimum Upload Speed: **512 kbps**
 - A stable internet connection is essential throughout the examination.
2. **Operating System**
 - The **Secure Exam Browser (MSB)** is compatible only with **Microsoft Windows 7 or later**.
 - Candidates must download and install the Secure Exam Browser (MSB) on their desktop or laptop before the examination.
3. **Pop-up Settings**
 - Configure your browser to **Allow Once** or **Always Allow** pop-ups to ensure that the examination window opens successfully.
4. **Browser Cache and Cookies**
 - Candidates are advised to clear their browser cache and cookies before starting the examination.
 - For most browsers (such as **Google Chrome** and **Mozilla Firefox**), press **Ctrl + Shift + Delete**, select the option to clear **Cache** and **Cookies**, and then proceed with the examination.
