

Inauguration of Symposium on Cyber Defence at NISM, Patalganga

The Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI), the National Institute of Securities Markets (NISM) and Rashtriya Raksha University (RRU) jointly inaugurated the **five-day Symposium on Cyber Defence** at the NISM campus on August 17, 2026. The Symposium brings together senior officials, cybersecurity professionals, experts and international participants from India and 15 countries to deliberate on the evolving cyber threat landscape and strengthen cyber defence capabilities and resilience in the financial sector.

The inaugural session witnessed addresses by **Shri K. V. R. Murthy and Shri Sandip Pradhan, Whole Time Members, SEBI; Shri Sashi Krishnan, Director, NISM; and Shri Avneesh Pandey, Executive Director, SEBI**. The Symposium was honoured by the presence of **Shri Tuhin Kanta Pandey, Chairman, SEBI**, and **Prof. Bimal Patel, Vice-Chancellor, RRU**. Prof. Patel highlighted the need to protect critical financial infrastructure and strengthen cyber capabilities in line with the rapid growth and increasing complexity of India's financial markets.

In his inaugural address, **Shri Tuhin Kanta Pandey** emphasised that cybersecurity is fundamental to maintaining the integrity, stability and confidence of India's securities markets. He stressed that cybersecurity is not merely an IT function, but an **institution-wide responsibility** requiring awareness, preparedness and coordinated action across organisations.

During the ceremony, Shri Pandey inaugurated two new SEBI portals—the **Incident Reporting Portal** and the **SEBI Cyber Suraksha Portal**—to strengthen cyber-incident reporting, monitoring, knowledge sharing and cybersecurity preparedness across the securities market ecosystem. He also inaugurated the **NISM Compliance & RegTech Lab**, which aims to bridge the gap between regulatory concepts and their practical implementation through simulation-based learning and industry-grade RegTech platforms, covering areas such as client screening, risk profiling, transaction monitoring, investigation and regulatory reporting.

The Symposium provides an international platform for exchange of knowledge, experience and best practices in cyber defence. Over the next four days, participants will engage in technical sessions, expert interactions, hands-on exercises and practical simulations covering **cyber incident response, threat detection, incident handling, recovery planning and emerging cyber risks associated with evolving technologies**.

The Symposium reinforces the commitment of **SEBI, NISM and RRU** to strengthening cybersecurity preparedness, fostering international cooperation and building institutional capabilities to address emerging cyber threats and create a secure and resilient financial ecosystem.
